



Job Description - Latin Teacher

Position Objective:

To instill a love for learning and a love for God in the hearts and minds of your students, and to encourage Latin mastery of conjugations, declensions, vocabulary, and grammar as appropriate for each grade level (grades 3-8).

Values:

Employees of The River Academy must agree with and strive to live their lives in accordance with our Statement of Faith, our core values, and our written policies and procedures.

Key Results Areas: A successful Latin teacher:

- Creatively prepares daily lessons according to the River Academy's assigned course content
- Writes weekly lesson plans that outline lesson objective, content, and student assessment
- Actively instructs students toward content mastery, and when content mastery is not achieved, works to help students understand key concepts
- Monitors student progress through weekly assignments or tests
- Grades and returns student work/tests in a timely fashion
- Positively participates with other River Academy teachers and staff in a way that fosters teamwork
- Builds student relationships inside and outside of the classroom (including attending annual student retreat and participating in House activities)
- Communicates with parents as needed regarding student progress and behavior
- Maintains a physical classroom that is both organized and visually appealing
- Performs other related duties as assigned
- Nurtures and supports students in their growing faith, knowledge of the Bible, and relationship with Christ and others

Supervision:

- The Latin teacher reports directly to the Secondary Principal

Classification:

- All teachers at The River Academy are considered faculty positions (see staff manual for details) and are exempt employees

Education and Experience:

- Bachelor's degree in education or related field preferred

Required skills, abilities, and physical qualifications:

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills (especially with students)
- Excellent interpersonal skills and organizational skills
- Proven ability to teach students
- Must be able to lift up to 15 pounds at times
